### **Ada City School District to Offer Meals During School Closure**

Beginning Monday, March 23rd, the Ada City School District Child Nutrition Program will provide meals for children Age 18 and under at six strategically located *Drive-through/Walk-Up* stations throughout the City of Ada. The six serving sites consist of four school sites and two “Bus Stop” sites.

**Breakfast and lunch will be provided with one stop service at every location.**

**Beginning Monday, March 23rd and continuing each weekday through Friday, April 3, 2020, meal pick-up will be available from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. each day.**

**“Bus Stop” *Grab and Go* Meals:**

The Drive through/walk-up stations have been designed for easy, curbside access. *We will provide “Grab and Go” meals only.* School District personnel will be on hand to distribute meals to children Age 18 and under as you drive into the parking lot or as you walk up to a designated location. **Due to Federal and State Child Nutrition Guidelines, meals may only be disbursed to children who are present.**
