Dear Parent,

Oklahoma Statute, §70-11-103.3, mandates Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) prevention education be taught in the public schools of this state. AIDS prevention education shall be limited to the discussion of the disease AIDS and its spread and prevention.

Ada City Schools will be providing AIDS Prevention Education for students in 8th and 10th grade on the following dates:

- AJHS will provide this lesson during 8th grade science on May 16 – 17 depending upon your child's schedule.
- AHS will deliver instruction through biology classes on May 16.

The State Department of Education has developed curriculum and materials in conjunction with the State Department of Health. The curriculum is limited in time frame to deal only with factual medical information for AIDS prevention.
